More Competitions Added at ACE 2011

We're pleased to announce that we will now be offering an optional "side tournament" every day during the dinner break (don't worry, there'll still be plenty of time to eat) this summer at camp. This is in addition to the tournaments that take place each night after dinner and the individual tournaments on the first and last day.

We're also adding a second subject area tournament on the last day, giving students the opportunity to compete in two different subjects (history, literature, science, fine arts, and RMP (Religion/Myth/Philosophy)).

All told, 2011 ACE campers will have the chance to compete in 9 tournaments and 6 practice sessions totalling more than 30 hours "on-the-buzzer" over the course of the week. This is in addition to the three quizbowl-centered classes that students take each day.
